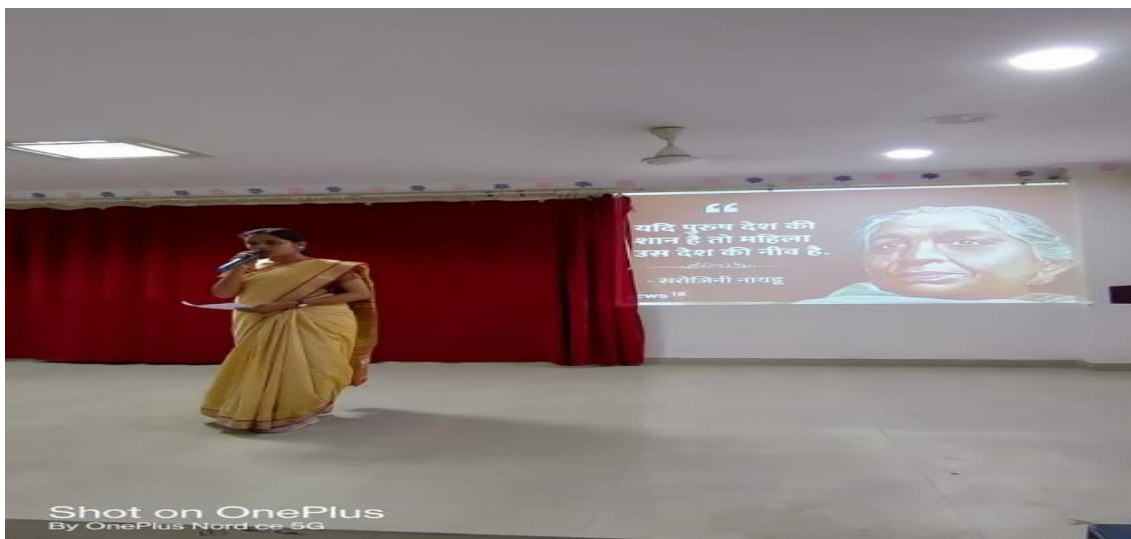
INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2024-2025

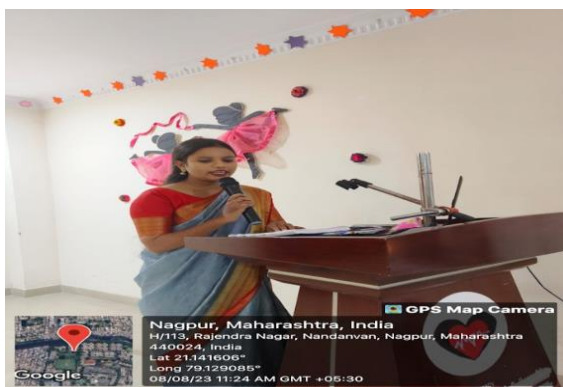

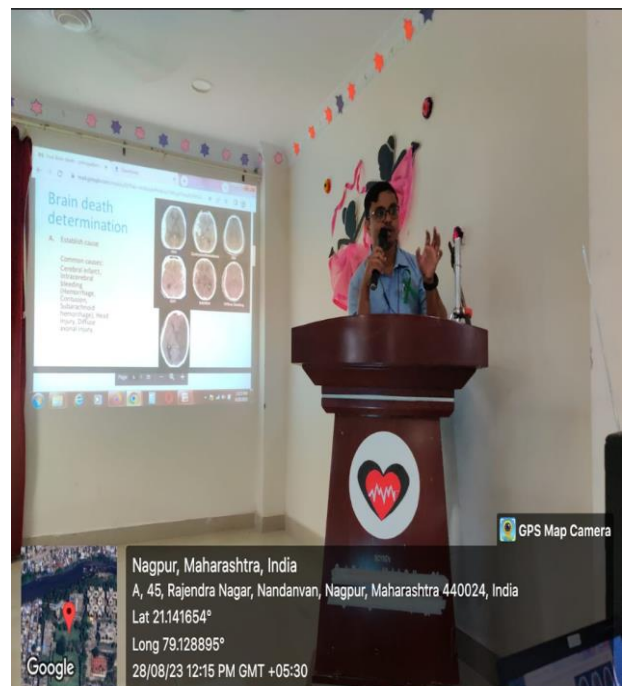

The event was successfully organized and planned by the students.



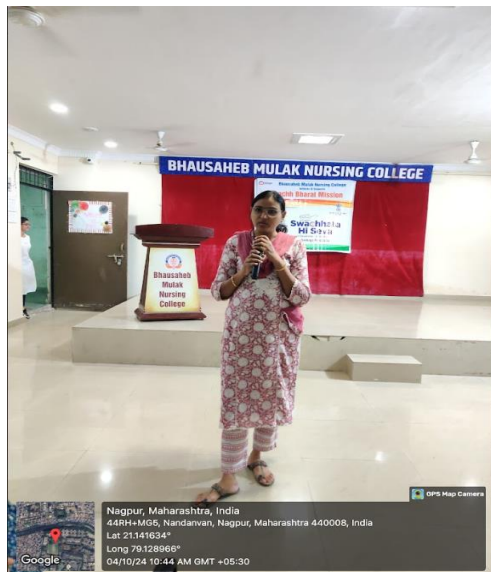
WORLD HEART DAY

Students also prepared various dishes as per instructions. Students got to learn in depth about nutritional aspect of various dishes.

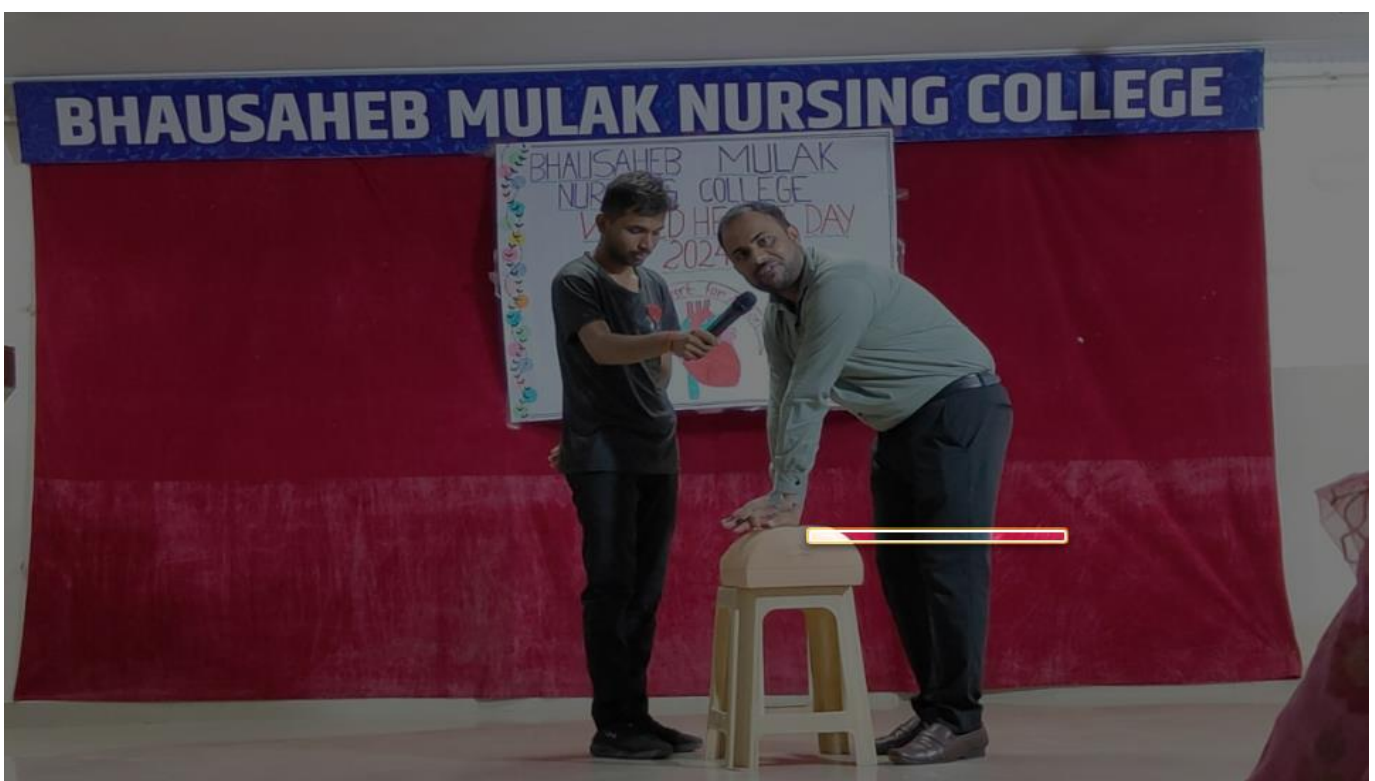
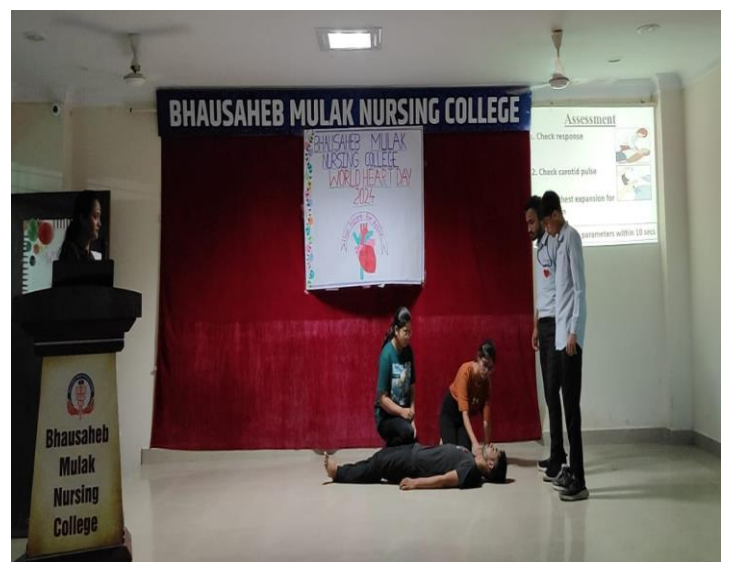
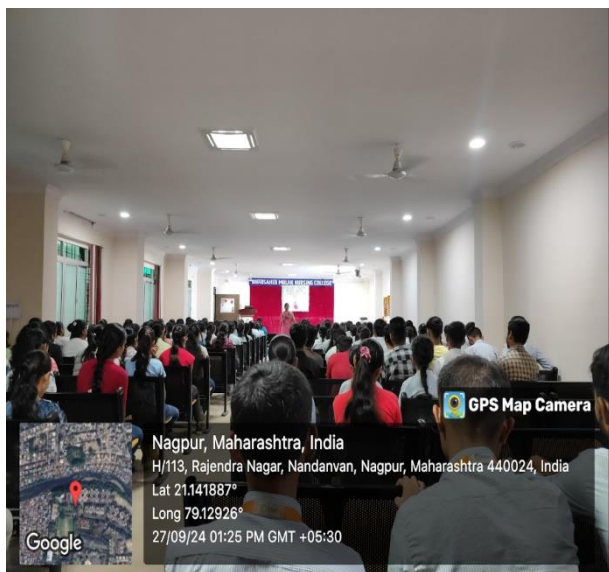
