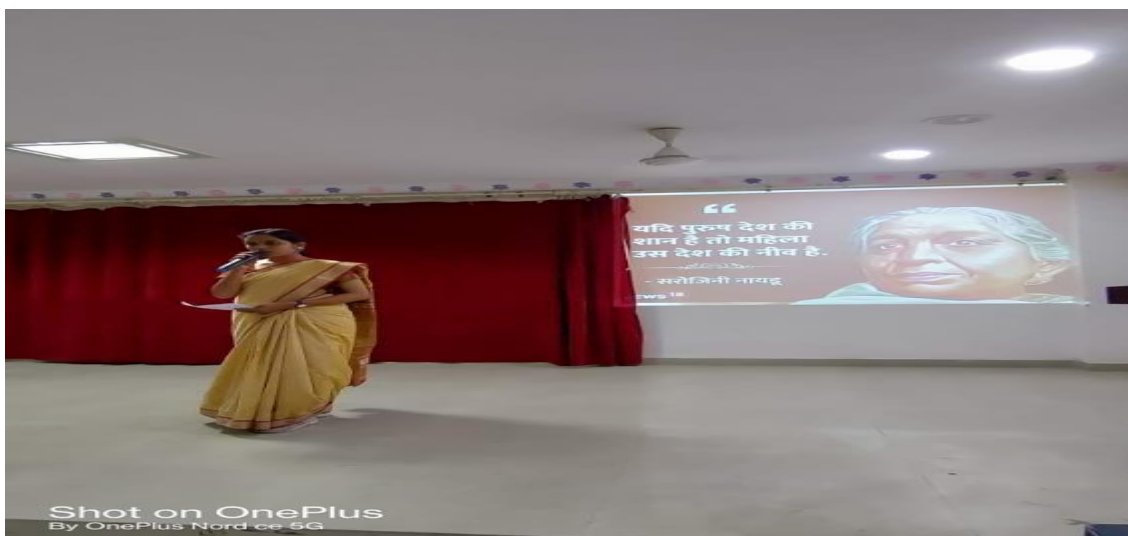
INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2025-2026

Slogan competition was organised and winners were awarded for their creative and message through the competition. It was a fantastic celebration!





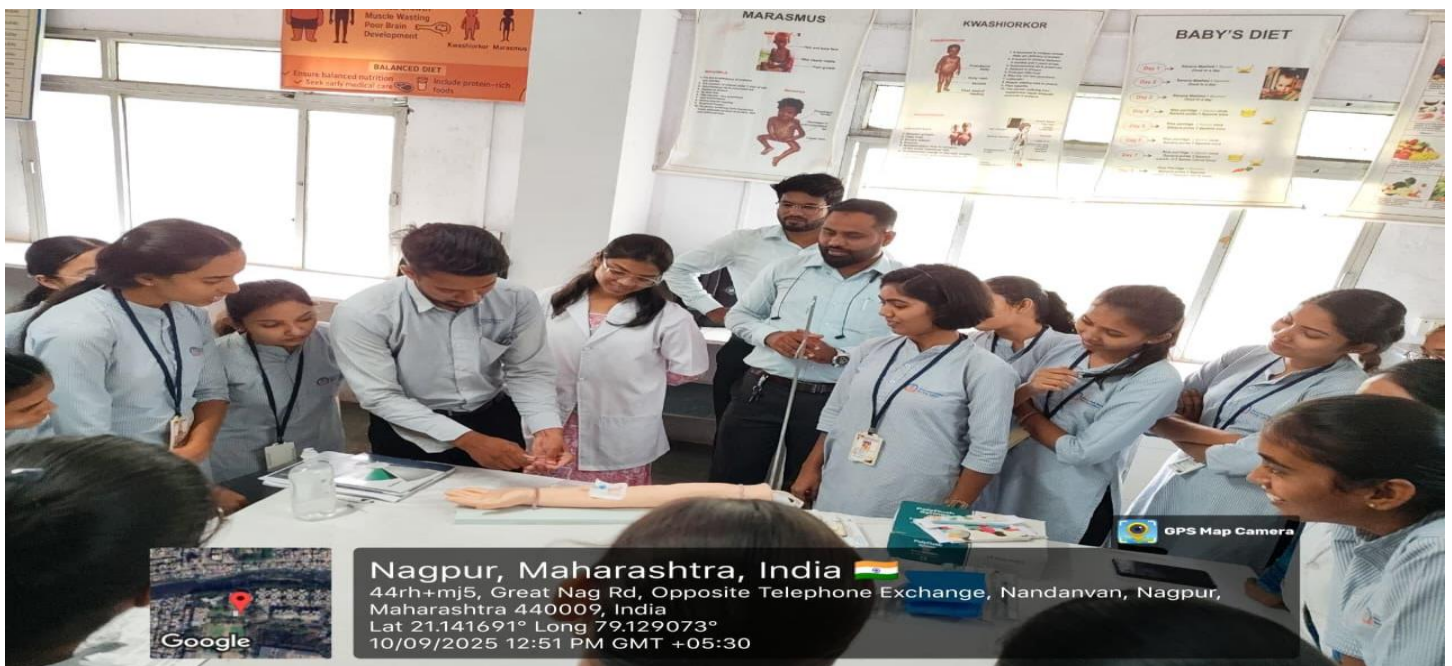
SKILLATHON WORKSHOP

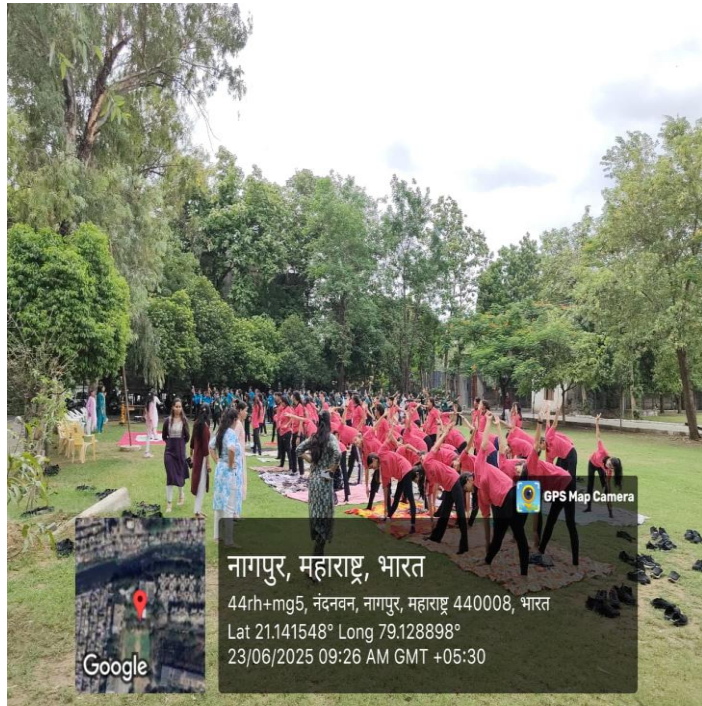
